| 2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by the insertion, in the appropriate place of the following definition:
“Commissioner-General” means the Commissioner-General of the Zambia Revenue Authority appointed under the Zambia Revenue Authority Act; | Amendment of Regulation 2

| 3. Regulation 3 is amended—
(a) in sub-regulation (1) by the insertion immediately after the words “compliance with” of the words “taxation measures”; and
(b) by the insertion of the following after subsection (4):

(5) The Commissioner-General shall have access to the monitoring system for the purpose of verifying compliance with taxation measures. | Amendment of Regulation 3 |

 - (c) compliance with taxation measures on behalf of the Commissioner-General.; and
 - (c) in subsection (5) by the insertion after the words “call detail records” of the words “and taxation compliance” wherever they appear.
